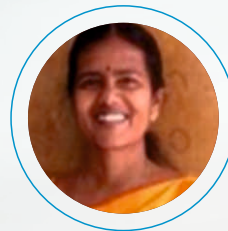

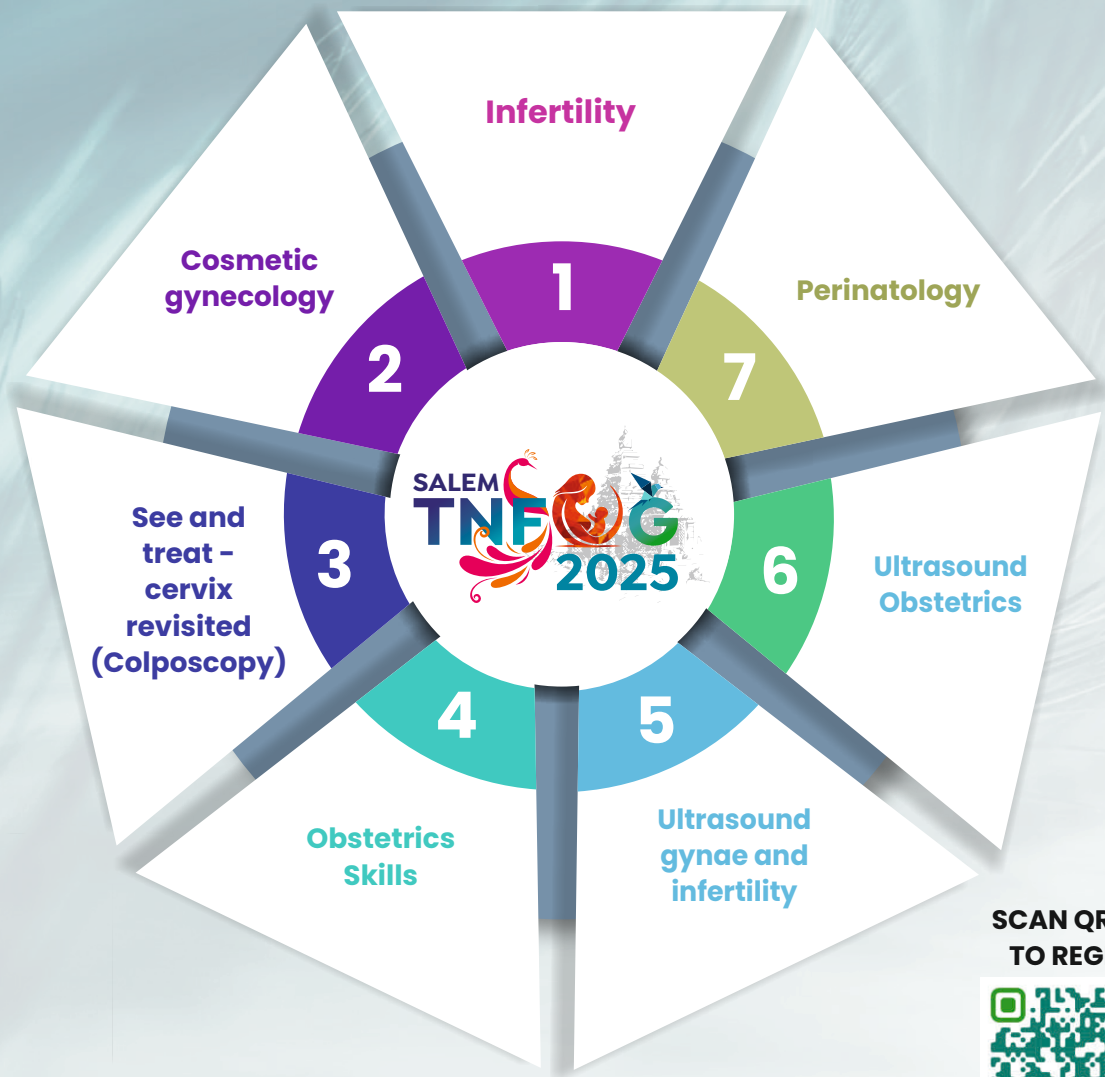

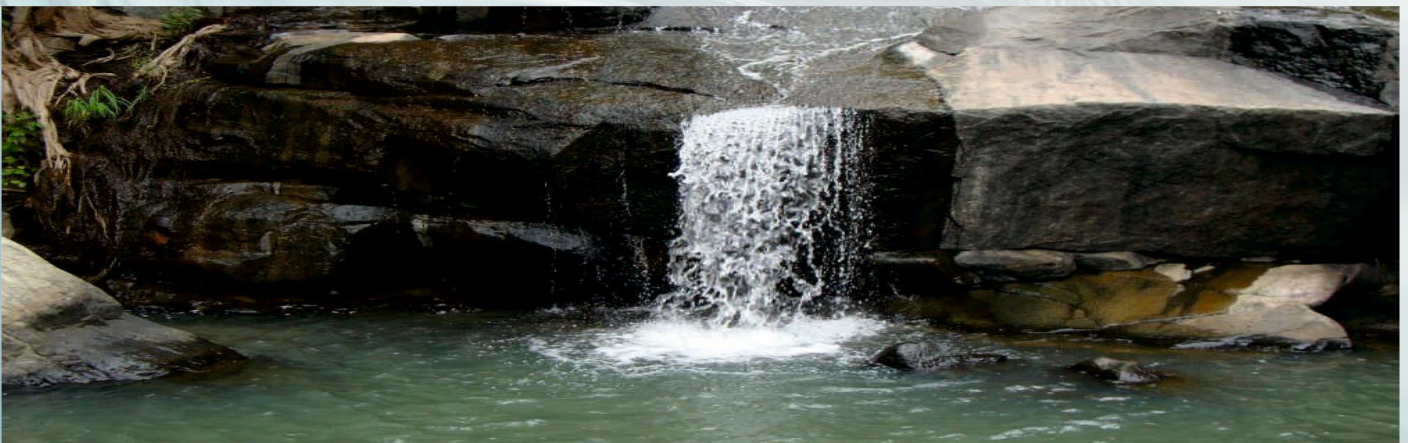

Salem is the fourth largest city in Tamil Nādu. The city is surrounded by hills. In fact, the name Salem is derived from the word “**Sailem**” meaning an area surrounded by mountains. Salem is also known as the “**Steel City** and “**Mango City**”.

The history of **Salem** dates back to the third century B.C. The city was a part of the Pandya, Pallava, and Vijayanagara Empires. After the defeat of Tipu Sultan in the Third Anglo-Mysore War in 1792, the State of Mysore’s border was re-aligned, and the British formed the Salem district under Madras Presidency.

Numerous forts and temples in the city date back to a previous era. Salem is a Geologist’s paradise and is rich in a variety of important minerals like Magnesite, Dunite, Bauxite, Limestone, Iron ore, Quartz, Feldspar Soapstone, Granites, etc. As a district, Salem has its significance in various aspects. Salem is one of the major producers of traditional silver anklets, which are popular among women. Salem is a major textile center in Tamil Nadu and also houses a number of sago factories.



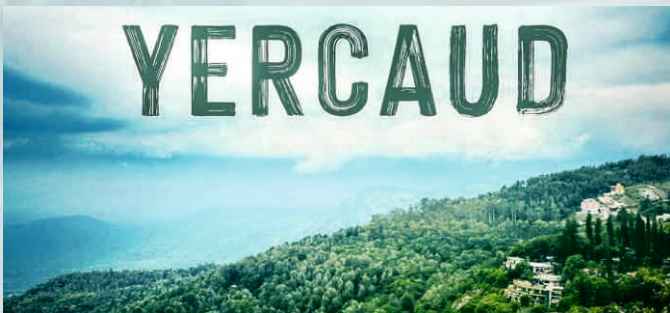
PLACES TO VISIT IN SALEM

Yercaud

The mountainous town of Yercaud is located in Tamil Nadu's Salem district. It is situated in the mountain range of Shevaroy Mountain in the Eastern Ghats. Sarvarayana Temple, which rises 5326 feet above sea level and is located at 1515 meters above sea level, is the highest point in Yercaud. It is one of Yercaud's most popular tourist attractions. The climate is ideal, and Yercaud is home to several coffee fields. Yercaud Lake is the area's main attraction. One of the region's major attractions is the May summer festival. It is devoted to Lord Sarvarayana, the supreme God of the mountains.

Oothumalai Hill – Trek To The Top

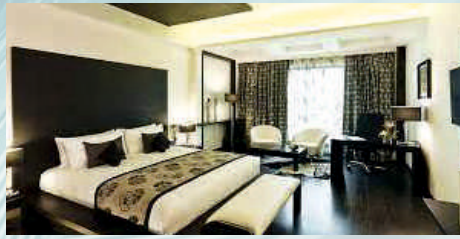
